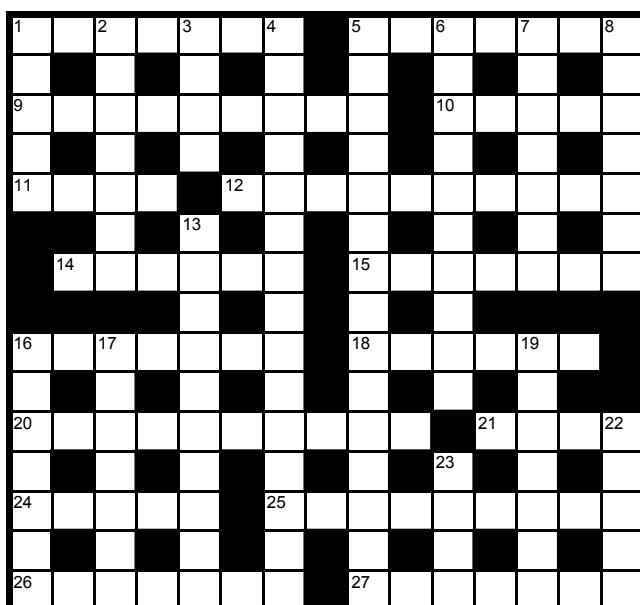


Crossword No. 2, set by Lemminkäinen
